- **B.** Concentrate on what KIDS NEED MOST
 - a. <u>Godly PURPOSE</u> Their life has meaning and that purpose can only be found in God through intense prayer, consistent Bible study, lifestyle worship, and wise counsel

- Godly PASSION We need model, instill, and ignite tremendous excitement and energy for God. Help kids imagine that being devoted to anything else in life is worthless.

- c. <u>Godly PERSEVERANCE</u> Teach kids to rely on Him regardless of the circumstances. Knowing with certainty what our life's purpose is enables us to muster the mental, moral, and spiritual strength and self-confidence to keep moving ahead toward the fulfillment of what really matters.

- d. Godly POWER Kids need to know that they can accomplish great and amazing things through the power of the Holy Spirit - things they could not possibly do on their own; things that do not happen naturally but supernaturally
 - i. Acts 1:8
- e. <u>Godly PLEASURE</u> When we are doing God's will and doing it the way He has intended it for us, we will find a level of fulfillment unlike any we could otherwise experience in life.

- f. <u>Godly PEOPLE</u> Parents, pastors, teachers, leaders, encouragers people who influence their lives for the good!
- C. Our responsibility as a church is to REACH children so they do not have to be RESCUED!
